Open call for tenders ECHA/2013/03

Provision of an HR System, Implementation and Support Services

Question 5.1:

As we are placed in the (*deleted*) market and have not worked in the Finnish market yet we do not currently have a partner/subcontractor in Finland that would be able to sign the required letter of intent of subcontractor. However, as our product is HR software for (*deleted*), we know that (*deleted*) has local partners in Finland that will be able to carry out the maintenance etc.

The question is therefore; is it possible for us to hand in an offer to you without the letter of intent from a subcontractor? – or will we then automatically be counted out?

Answer:

Tenderers are requested to submit offers that meet all the requirements of the Specifications of this Call for Tenders, including maintenance of the proposed HR solution as described in Annex 5.1.1 (Technical Specifications, section 3.3). It is within the discretion of the tenderers to decide how they will carry out the required maintenance, and whether they will rely on partners or sub-contractors or not for that purpose. As for sub-contractors we refer to section 3.5.2 of the Specifications. In case the tenderer relies on a sub-contractor for the provision of part of the requested services the documents described in Section 4.1.2.1 of the Specifications (Administrative proposal) shall be provided.
