

## **SCIENTIFIC OFFICER – Integrated Regulatory Strategy; ref.: ECHA/SNE/2019/004**

### **JOB DESCRIPTION:**

The Seconded National Expert will work in the Prioritisation and Integration Directorate supporting the implementation of the [Integrated Regulatory Strategy](#). The SNE will take part in one or several of the activities listed below:

- Implementing the approach to manage groups of substances and developing it further
  - Screening REACH/CLP and other databases to identify groups of substances of concern
  - Identifying the needs to generate further hazard data
  - Identifying regulatory risk management measures under REACH/CLP or other Union legislation;
- Supporting the co-operation with Member State authorities; and/
- Monitoring and reporting on the progress in addressing substances of potential concern.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

Education: Successful completion of a full course of university studies attested by a degree in chemistry, (eco)toxicology, engineering, information technology or in a related field where the normal duration of university education is three (3) or more years.

Experience:

- At least 3 (three) years of experience in one or more of the following areas: data mining and analysis, human health or environmental risk assessment, company level or regulatory risk management related to chemicals.
