Information on how companies can submit data to ECHA will be published next week

The European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) will publish early next week on its website information specifying how to submit data to the Agency from 1 June. Detailed guidance will be available in a new data submission web section. Web pages will be launched stepwise for pre-registrations, PPORD notifications, inquiries and registrations.

Geert Dancet, Executive Director of ECHA, said that 'ECHA is working hard to ensure that industry will be able to fulfil all its obligations upon the entry into operation of REACH on 1 June. Companies are encouraged to follow closely the Agency's website for the latest information on how to submit.

Next week the final testing will be completed on the REACH-IT system and ECHA will confirm the necessary procedures companies need to follow to submit data to the Agency. When these procedures have been confirmed, ECHA will announce them stepwise on its website and communicate them to Member State helpdesks, REACH Competent Authorities and through other networks to industry and stakeholders.
