Conclusions

- *Promoting data quality through Dialogue*
 - *General consensus on the concept*
 - *Further discussion needed: no decision taken yet*
 - *Quality of the input defines the success of the system*
 - *Scope of the "discussion" is critical:*
 - *No political discussions*
 - *Other use(rs) to be further elaborated on (e.g. other authorities)*
- *Scope of the system to be clarified*
 - *Feedback on quality*
 - *Further clarification from authorities*
 - *How would it relate to the C&L platform*

- *Next steps for ICBP*
 - *Challenging year ahead; ambitious but realistic*
