- 4. Addressing the scientific challenges

REACH/CLP challenges ahead

For ECHA:

- Registration deadlines in 2013, 2018
- Identifying all SVHCs and selecting the most suitable risk management option for each of them by 2020
- Using REACH for substances in nanoform

For you:

- Update your dossiers better quality means safer use
- Prepare for registration there is even more support available now



Other challenges ahead

- Biocidal Products Regulation (BPR)
 - Entry into force this summer
 - Entry into operation on 1 September 2013
 - Simplifies the authorisation procedures in the internal market
 - Ensures protection of human and animal health, and the environment
- Prior Informed Consent Regulation (PIC)
 - Entry into force this summer
 - Entry into operation on 1 March 2014
 - Regulates import/export of hazardous chemicals in compliance with CLP
- These laws bring opportunities also for you we will do our best to inform and support you
