Key messages

- Identify clearly the scope of your registration
- Include detailed physicochemical description of the registered substance
- Same provisions apply to nanomaterials as to any other substances under REACH, however there are specific considerations that the registrant should report in specific endpoint sections to facilitate the evaluation of the provided information.
- The use of grouping/read-across approach between different (forms of a) substance(s) should be adequately justified and documented.
