WORK EXPERIENCE

Since 12/2016 : sub-director for environmental health and safety in the general directorate for risk prevention (*french ministry of environment, energy and sea*): preparation of environment health and safety national policy. Interministerial policy steering on chemicals (including phytopharmaceuticals and biocids) , and on farms under the regulation of installations classified for the protection of environment. Handling the regional agencies and departmental units for the implementation of such policies. International participation (ECHA, UN...). Management of the expertise carried out by public institutes or research institutions. Representative for the ministry of environment for the GMOs and biotechnology.
