I have been involved in chemicals management and related issues since 1999, when I joined the Chemicals Notification Centre. I was involved in the accession negotiation process, transposition and implementation of the EU Acquis, and different projects of chemicals management at national level.

Professional experience

I am the Head of Chemical Safety Department in the Health Board in Estonia since 2010. The department serves as the National Competent Authority for REACH, CLP, Biocides, Detergents, Cosmetics, Tobacco, Export-Import Regulations, Rotterdam Convention and Chemical Weapons Convention. The department acts as the first point of contact for questions related to the BPR, CLP and REACH regulations as well as Poison Information Centre. Prior to joining the Health Board I was Manager of Chemicals Notification Centre.

In addition I am a member of the Estonian Chemical Safety Commission, which assesses problems concerning chemical safety issues, evaluates and provides opinions on the chemical safety policy and strategies. I was a member of Member State Committee 2008 - 2018.

Education

I graduated from the Tallinn Technical University in 1979 with Master's degree in chemical technology and chemical processes. 2004 I had training in the area of toxicology, ecotoxicology and risk assessment of chemicals. It was a basic toxicology course BTox organized by Department of Environmental Toxicology at Uppsala University collaboration with University of Tartu.
