## Key messages (1)

- Legal entity synchronisation between REACH-IT and IUCLID 5
- Identify accurately your substance in IUCLID 5
- Create the joint submission in REACH-IT well in advance
- As a lead registrant you need to provide members with:
  - Exact name of the joint submission
  - Security token

## Key messages (2)

- Use IUCLID plug-ins before submission:
  - TCC plug-in
  - Fee calculator
  - Dissemination plug-in
- Submit the lead registration dossier early enough
  - Recommended by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2013
- Remind members they also need to submit their registration dossier before the deadline of 31<sup>st</sup> May 2013

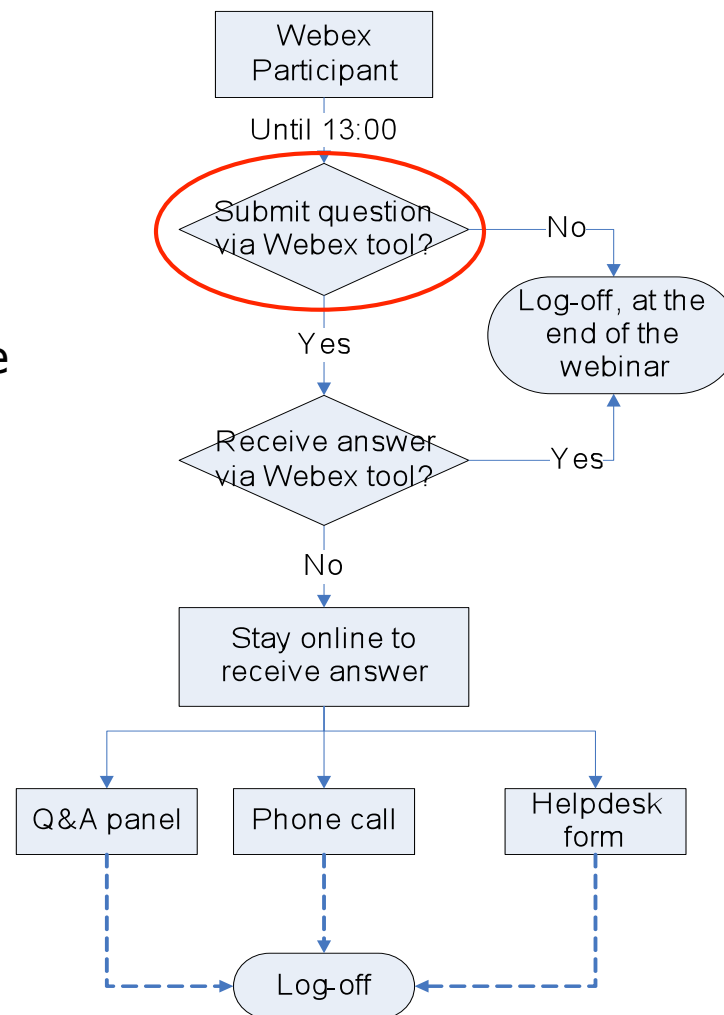
