Audio broadcast

- Audio available directly through the event centre tool

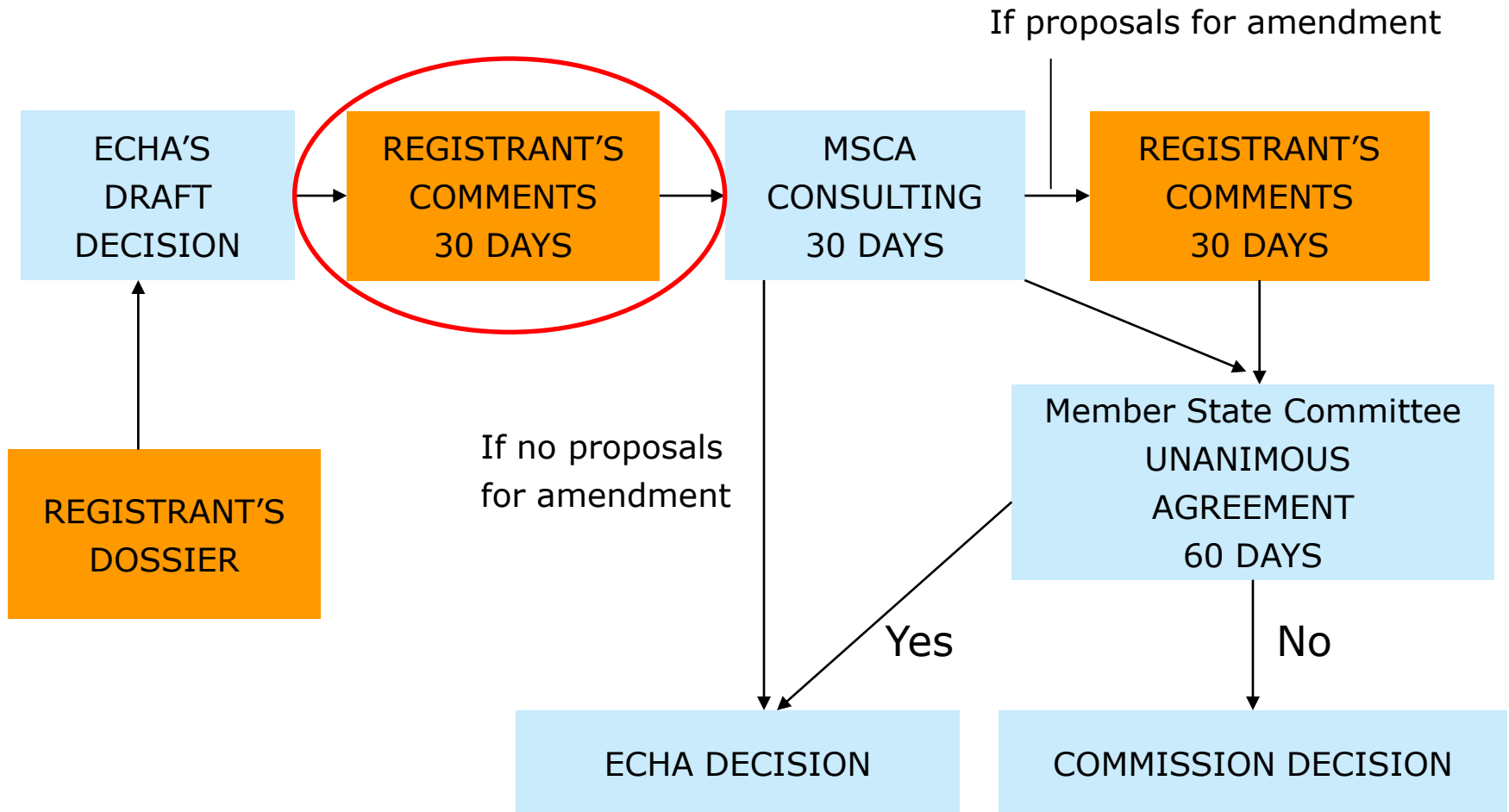
