Travel instructions from the airport

- *By train*
Two train lines go to the Central Railway Station from the airport in 30 minutes. The fare costs 5.50 € (Regional ticket adult):

In the timetable:
Airport = Lentoaseman asema Central Railway Station = Helsinki Platform = Laituri
- *By taxi*
The journey takes about 20–30 minutes and costs about 40 €. Taxis are available in front of both terminal 1 and 2.
- *By airport taxi yellow line*
The airport taxi yellow line offers a collective taxi service to and from the airport for a fixed price. You can reserve Airport Taxi Shuttle from either the service points at the arrival terminals from 6 am to 1:30 pm, online or by calling +358 600 555 555 (Mon-Fri 8 am-9 pm, weekends 12 pm-9 pm). - *By Finnair Citybus*
The journey takes about 35 minutes from the airport directly to the Central Railway Station. The price of the ticket is 6.60 €. The bus leaves every 20 minutes from 5:45 am to 1:10 am in front of both terminals 1 and 2. For the route and the timetable, please consult this site: <https://bit.ly/2mIVKGM>.
- *By bus*
Bus 615 takes about 40 minutes and it leaves from both terminals 1 and 2 to the railway station every 15 min and costs 5.50 €. For further information and the timetable, please consult the Reittiopas: <https://bit.ly/2MPSgxr>

Travel instructions from the railway station to ECHA

From the Central Railway Station it takes 10 to 15 minute walk to ECHA.

In front of the railway station, you can also take Tram 6 from Rautatieasema stop to Fredrikinkatu stop, which is the closest to ECHA.
