

Wrap-up and conclusions

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General considerations

- SCIP database to be seen as an enabler for actions by consumers, industry and waste operators. The key objective is not just to get the information in the database, but to see what is actually done with it
- We need to clarify with Member States and the Commission what is the right level of reporting (how many levels for complex articles), ensuring it is still meaningful to the users
- Supply chains are global, need to raise awareness, also outside the EU



Efficient notification procedures

- S2S can be efficient solution, but more information needed by industry as soon as possible
- Primary identifiers are key for updates and managing the data. Secondly, it could be used for sharing data in the supply chain
- Managing accounts of different legal entities can help conglomerates, consultants and software providers
- The redistribution model can provide for simplified notifications for distributors (when the article is no longer changed by the different suppliers)



Dissemination and user needs

- All data made public (with exception of CBI), in a crude form at first and improved over time.
- Waste operators currently lack (useable) information
- Article level is the right level of reporting, as it allows aggregation where needed
- Need to work towards waste streams free of SVHCs, but problem with legacy articles will remain for a while
- Consumer right to know to be balanced vs. CBI
- Different needs for different audiences is key in dissemination vision: ECHA has a keen interest in further collaboration with users (waste operators and consumers) to better understand their needs



What's next?

- Release of the prototype (v0, Q1 2020)
 - Functionalities to create dossier
 - No public view on the data yet
- Next phase of development
 - Submission functionalities released as they become available
 - Testing phase, implementation of improvements
 - Analysis of dissemination portal
- Release of SCIP v1 (planned for OCT '20)
