#### **Objective and mandate of the WG**

- Review annually a list of proposals for REF projects submitted by Forum members, ECHA Secretariat, the Commission and the Stakeholder Organisations accredited by ECHA (ASOs)
- Prioritise the subjects by applying Forum's methodology for the prioritisation, selection and management of REF projects
- Draft a recommendation proposing the subject for the next REF project and pilot projects



#### **Prioritisation process**

- All new proposals considered during prioritisation process of REF-9
- Forum methodology assessing mandatory (e.g. relevancy, added value etc.) and optional criteria (risk, feasibility etc.)
- All mandatory criteria has to be fulfilled
- Optional critera fulfilled = better rating



#### **Topic for the REF-9 project**

#### Authorisation

- Project combining suggestions from different submitters
- Enforcement of Title VII of REACH- substances in Annex XIV with sunset dates 2015 and later. All suppliers and downstream users
- Cooperation with Customs
- Conditions for authorisation
- Potential screening of Annex XIV substances via environmental permits databases





### Forum pilot project

- Topic chosen by the Forum members from the original REF proposals, that was identified by the WG as suitable for a pilot project:
- CLP bridging principles for classification provisions applicable to cleaning / detergent products
  - No common understanding among Member States on the interpretation of the concerned legal obligation
  - Non-harmonized approach is a risk
