	The eMSCA considers that the substance evaluation of TDCP should be postponed, although the final report for a carcinogenicity study on the structurally related chlorinated phosphate ester TCPP (CAS 13674-84-6) which has been conducted within the scope of the US National Toxicology Programme (NTP) has been published on the NTP website recently. Reason: the eMSCA considers that a request for data via a compliance check (CCH) by ECHA on related endpoints like e.g. mutagenicity is essential before a decision is made on the need to eventually conduct a substance evaluation on TDCP. Hence, the eMSCA considers that a temporary withdrawal of TDCP is warranted until the CCH has been initiated and further information obtained as a result of the CCH has been assessed.
