Acceptance of notification – Dismate PE – UK-2016-1028.

We refer to your notification of the biocidal product Dismate PE – UK-2016-1028, (Case no BC-LR027452-27), according to article 27 of the Regulation (EU) No 528/2012.

Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 is implemented in Norwegian law through the Norwegian Biocide Regulation of 10 April 2014 No. 548. According to Article 27(1) of BPR the authorisation holder shall notify a product authorised under Article 26 of BPR to Competent Authority in the member state at least 30 days before is to be placed on the market in that member state.

Decision

Subject to Article 27(1) of the BPR, cf. § 1 of the Norwegian Biocide Regulation, the Norwegian Environment Agency accepts the notification of Dismate PE in product type 19. The Norwegian Environment Agency hereby confirms that the product can be placed on the Norwegian market in accordance with the terms and conditions in the simplified product authorisation granted by United Kingdom.
